About Us


PIECE OF HEAVEN PROJECT (POHP) IS A SANCTUARY FOR BOTH ANIMALS AND HUMANS. WE OFFER A PLACE OF SAFETY, HEALING AND LEARNING.

Home to over 100 rescued animals and located on 95 acres in a very secluded spot in Burton, British Columbia, the sanctuary is a wonderfully tranquil refuge, where the loudest non-animal sound is the rushing of the distant creek, as it races towards the lake.

Through a unique combination of animal rescue, retreat offerings, and corporate education, POHP promotes the adoption of a compassionate lifestyle and the vegan philosophy, in service of the future of the planet and all its inhabitants.



HISTORY



When they came to Canada seeking a different kind of lifestyle, they brought with them their animal family of two cats and six dogs. Word soon got around that they were prepared to rescue dogs and seven years later, it was necessary to move, just so that they could keep offering them a safe home.

Their new home in British Columbia came with a lot of land that was beautiful, but served no purpose. But not long after relocating, they were asked to take in a small herd of unwanted alpacas that were destined for dog meat. They didn't hesitate, and the Piece Of Heaven Project was born. Today, they have over 100 animals of 13 species.

Strategy

OUR GOALS

To promote the welfare of animals for the benefit of the public by rescuing and providing care for stray, abandoned, abused, or surrendered animals.

HOW WE'LL GET THERE

Provide safe and caring forever homes to at least 10 species of animals.

To advance education for the public by providing educational material in all formats including online and face to face workshops, seminars, classes, and presentations on animal practices, rescue, care; and the reduction of animal suffering.

To promote wellbeing through the provision of education, healing and support to adopt a compassionate life style. Develop and Deliver a programme of animal advocacy education and learning suitable for both adults and children.

Develop and deliver a programme of learning to support improvement of wellbeing for humans, animals and the planet including the provision of a residential retreat.

PRESENT

The Sanctuary – Creating a place of safety for animals free from cruelty and exploitation of any kind.

Our Future

EDUCATION

Stemming from Mark Starmer's unique experience in corporate education, POHP has founded a sister organisation, Plant Based Future Ltd, to foster direct engagement with corporations. Through Plant Based Future, we will work with companies to educate staff on the environmental impact of their dietary choices in this time of critical need. Through the use of a yet-to-be-developed app, we will aggregate the dietary data logged by employees to demonstrate the collective impact of choosing plant-based foods.

The cascade model employed for this active learning intervention (which has already attracted attention from global corporate giants), relies upon the captive nature of the corporate audience, and subtle peer pressure. It is a methodology that has already proven to be effective in starting global net zero initiatives.

ON-SITE EXPERIENCE

We intend to make POHP a sanctuary for humans as well as animals, by opening to a wider audience as an eco-tourist destination where individuals can come to learn and reconnect. By experiencing the harmony of this 'piece of heaven,' decompressing from the pressures of a carnist dominated world, and spending time forming bonds with animals and nature, we intend for visitors to (re)connect with a sense of vegan purpose and leave with a deeper commitment to being effective animal advocates.

With the support of 180 Degrees Consulting, we have created detailed plans to finance, build the infrastructure for, and operationalise a glamping style retreat, enabling people to stay and learn.
